**ITEM TITLE:**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF MODIFICATION NO. 2 TO GRANT AGREEMENT NO. 4337-330-A WITH THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FDEM) FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE EXISTING SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM PROJECT KNOWN AS CITY 2, PROVIDING FOR AN EXTENSION TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND A BUDGET INCREASE; AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2025–2026 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$392,307 TO RECOGNIZE THE BUDGET INCREASE AS REVENUE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID MODIFICATION.

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

The City of Coral Gables and the Florida Division of Emergency Management entered into a grant agreement in the amount of \$1,154,421 under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to improve the existing sanitary sewer connection system along Alcazar Avenue, between Ponce de Leon Boulevard and Galiano Street, and between Alhambra Plaza and Majorca Avenue.

The costs of the project exceeded the original estimate. As a result, the City requested a budget increase, which was approved by the grantor.

While the City awaited a decision for the budget increase, the grant agreement expired. This modification reinstates the agreement and extends its term through May 31, 2026.
