

Coral Gables Opioid Settlement Funds Implementation Plan – October 1, 2025 to September 30 2026

Overview

This implementation plan outlines how the City of Coral Gables intends to allocate and utilize the opioid settlement funds in alignment with the requirements of Schedules A and B of the opioid settlement. This plan details the specific areas of focus, the amount of funds dedicated to each area, and any associated purchases.

Funding Allocation

Schedule B: Approved Uses

The following areas will be funded under Schedule B:

1. Public Awareness Campaign

- **Amount:** \$51,670
- **Description:** Develop a program that will provide a structured 4-hour training program educating residents, students and schools on:
 1. Narcan (Naloxone) administration and overdose awareness
 2. Hand-Only CPR and AED familiarization
 3. Basic emergency response preparedness
- Each session will be delivered by a minimum of two firefighters operating in an instructional role. The program aims to strengthen public safety by empowering the community with life-saving skills prior to emergency responder arrival for opioid overdose.
- **Program Cost:** \$450 per class held
- **Hiring:** N/A (will use existing personnel)
- **Capital Outlay:** N/A
- **Vehicle Purchases:** N/A

2. Law Enforcement Training

- **Amount:** \$51,670
- **Description:** Equip law enforcement officers with training on:
 1. Understanding Opioid Use Disorder and co-occurring conditions.
 2. Recognizing Risk and responding to Opioid Use Disorder
 3. Best practices for field collaboration
 4. Real-world application and resource utilization
- Our law enforcement officers will be assigned to attend a 4-hour training session which will provide operational readiness on Opioid Use Disorder.
- **Program Cost:** \$450 per officer
- **Hiring:** N/A (training for existing personnel)
- **Capital Outlay:** N/A
- **Vehicle Purchases:** N/A

- **Total Settlement Funds:** \$103,340 (through fiscal year 2026)
- **Schedule A Allocation:** \$0

Implementation Timeline

- **Q3 2026:** Launch public awareness campaign
- **Q3 2026:** Enroll officers in Opioid Use Disorder training
