RESOLUTION 2021-_____

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A RECOMMENDATION TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE PROCESS OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE AND PURCHASE THE LUCAS AND LIFEPAK15 ANNUAL MAINTENANCE SERVICE AS A SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-689 OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department purchased the LUCAS and Lifepak15 devices starting in 2010 for their Rescues; and

WHEREAS, the LUCAS and Lifepak15 devices are utilized on all cardiac and cardiac arrest incidents by the Fire Department Paramedics; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has the need to renew the annual maintenance service agreement for a period of three (3) year at \$18,543.60 per year; and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking approval to purchase the on-going maintenance for the existing LUCAS and Lifepak15 devices; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-689 of the Procurement Code entitled "Sole Source Procurement" authorizes an award without competitive bids when there in only one source available to fulfill the needs of the city; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code, entitled "Authority" authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on contract awards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. That the City Commission accepts a recommendation to waive the competitive process and authorizes the City Manager to purchase the LUCAS and Lifepak15 devices' annual maintenance service, pursuant to Section 2-689 of the City's Procurement Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
