**ITEM TITLE:**

Transportation Advisory Board meeting minutes of May 20th, 2026

**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

- Meeting called to order at 5:32 PM by Roland Rodriguez; quorum was present.
- March meeting minutes approved unanimously.
- Discussion held regarding proposed bike lanes along Andalusia Avenue near Publix, including coordination with the future Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan and impacts from the Publix redevelopment project.
- Staff to provide future updates and share development plans with the Board for review and comment.
- Safety concerns discussed for pedestrian and bicycle crossings along US-1 and the Underline corridor, particularly near Caballero Boulevard and construction areas.
- Board emphasized the importance of maintaining safe pedestrian access during construction and evaluating long-term safety improvements.
- Updates provided on evaluation of bike lane safety treatments and traffic signal preemption initiatives.
- Discussion held regarding pedestrian-oriented improvements associated with the Ponce Circle Park redesign.
- Staff presented updates on citywide traffic calming projects, including proposed roundabouts, speed tables, sidewalk projects, and bicycle improvements.
- Strong public support noted for proposed roundabouts and ongoing roadway safety initiatives.
- Next TAB meeting scheduled for July 21st.
