

ITEM TITLE:

A Resolution of the City Commission authorizing the acceptance of a \$77,040 voucher from the U.S Department of Energy for the installation of solar panels on the roof of the Granada Diner located at 2001 Granada Blvd; authorizing the City Manager to execute the assistance agreement with the Department of Energy; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Annual Budget to recognize the funds as revenue and appropriate such funds towards the cost of the program.

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City has been allocated and awarded \$77,040 in the form of an equipment rebate voucher to support the installation of solar panels on the roof of the Granada Diner, located at 2001 Granada Boulevard.
