are in violation of the following sections of the City Code of the City of Coral Gables:

Sec. 82-29. - Permits generally.

(c)Tree abuse. Tree abuse is prohibited and shall constitute a violation of this section. Any act of tree abuse that renders a tree nonviable or effectively destroyed shall constitute "effective tremoval" and shall compel the owner to fully comply with the terms of this article as if the tree was removed prior to issuance of a permit.

## The following steps should be taken to correct the violation:

Remedy: Comply with Section 82-29. Must obtain a after-the-fact permit for tree cutting. Must submit a Arborist report, written by a Florida state, certified arborist to Coral Gables Greenspace division as to the viability of the tree, and any corrective measures needed. Contact Greenspace for additional requirements. 305-460-5000.

This is your notice to appear at said time and place. Failure to do so will result in the matter being heard in absentia. An administrative fee of \$108.75 will be assessed at the time of your hearing.
