WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1786, there are currently more than 24,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty, including 10 members of the Coral Gables Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, DC; and

WHEREAS, May 15 is designated as Peace Officers Memorial Day, in honor of all fallen officers and their families and U.S. flags should be flown at half-staff; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables pay solemn tribute to the officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty, and we offer our deepest sympathy to their families, friends, and colleagues;

NOW, I, VINCE LAGO, as Mayor of Coral Gables, along with the members of our City Commission, do hereby proudly proclaim the week of May 11-17, 2025 as:

"NATIONAL POLICE WEEK IN CORAL GABLES"

IN OBSERVANCE THEREOF, I do hereby encourage all citizens to honor the service and sacrifice of our law enforcement officers, to show appreciation for their daily efforts, and to remember those who gave their lives in the line of duty.
