RESOLUTION NO. 2008-190

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND THE REQUIRED TIME OUTLINED IN THE CONTRACT WITH ARCOART PLUS D/B/A TROLINET, FOR THE ON-BOARD TROLLEY AND PRINT ADVERTISEMENT PROJECT FROM THIRTY (30) DAYS TO NINETY (90) DAYS, IN ORDER TO BEGIN PAYMENT TO THE CITY FROM THE SALES PROCEEDS.

WHEREAS, the City Commission at its meeting of August 26, 2008 approved a Resolution authorizing the award of On-board Trolley and Print Advertisement to ArcoArt, d/b/a Trolinet; and

WHEREAS, since the contract has not been executed as yet, due to unforeseen circumstances, the vendor is requesting that the terms be modified to allow them to begin payment ninety (90) days from the full execution of the contract in lieu of the thirty (30) days, as stated in the contract; further stipulating that said modifications will allow them time to install the screens and equipment and to sell advertisement for digital signage programming;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the City Manager to modify the terms stipulated in the award of On-Board Trolley and Print Advertisement to ArcoArt d/b/a Trotline; thus allowing for start of payment to commence ninety (90) days from the full execution of the contract in lieu of the thirty (30) days originally agreed upon; further allowing them time to install the screens and equipment and to sell advertisement for digital signage programming.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
