RESOLUTION NO. 2009-249

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA MEDICAL TRAINING INSTITUTE TO ALLOW FOR EMT/PARAMEDIC STUDENTS TO RIDE ON RESCUE UNITS.

WHEREAS, the Coral Gables Fire Department has been mentoring EMT/Paramedic students by allowing them to "ride along" on their rescue units for over twenty years; and

WHEREAS, the Coral Gables Fire Department has been using this standardized contract for approximately six years; and

WHEREAS, there is no cost to the City of Coral Gables for this program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Florida Medical Training Institute to allow EMT/Paramedic students to ride on the Coral Gables Fire Department's rescue units, and

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


