Resolution.

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Coral Gables, Florida establishing a Historic Building Maintenance and Restoration Capital Project to be funded with an annual minimum amount of \$50,000. (Sponsored by Commissioner Castro)

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City owns several historic buildings and facilities, including City Hall, the Coral Gables Museum, the Miracle Theater, the H. George Fink Studio, and Venetian Pool, the Alhambra Water Tower, and City entrances, among others. The City is committed to preservation of its historic buildings. The proposed resolution finds that it is in the best interest of the City to establish a Historic Building Maintenance and Restoration Capital Project to be funded annually with a minimum amount of \$50,000.
