RESOLUTION NO. 2023-231

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FDEM), FOR THE CORAL GABLES CITYWIDE DRAINAGE PHASE I PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$74,546; AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 ANNUAL BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE \$74,546 GRANT AS REVENUE AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO COVER THE GRANT EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a competitive grant from the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) for the Coral Gables Citywide Drainage Phase I Project in the amount of \$74,546 to be used for the surveying, engineering, design, plans preparation, permitting and bidding costs of the project; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of Phase I of the project, Phase II in the amount of \$42,151 will be awarded to be used for construction cost; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is \$500,000 of which \$450,000 is from FDEM and \$50,000 is the required matching funds from the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends use of Stormwater Fund monies to meet the requirement of matched dollars; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$74,546 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures;

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby authorize the acceptance of a grant from the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) in the amount of \$74,546 to help improve the existing stormwater system.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby authorize use of Stormwater Funds monies to meet the requirement of matched dollars.

SECTION 3. Fiscal Year 2022-2023 annual budget is required to recognize the \$74,546 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
