RESOLUTION 2024-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION DIRECTING THE REALLOCATION OF FUNDS IN THE 2024-2028 FIVE YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN TO CREATE A CONCEPTUAL DESIGN FOR POTENTIAL IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING OUTDOOR COMMUNITY RECREATION SPACES, TO THE CORAL GABLES SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, the City Commission would like to budget up to \$50,000 in order to move forward with conceptual designs for potential improvements, including outdoor community recreation spaces, to the Coral Gables Senior High School athletic complex; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission directs staff to re-allocate \$50,000 from the War Memorial Youth Center capital project budget to this endeavor; and

WHEREAS, the City will work with Miami-Dade County Public Schools to initiate an agreement for the long-term joint use of the re-designed facilities; and

WHEREAS, the re-designed Coral Gables High School Athletic Complex will provide the community with public access to recreational and athletic amenities including new renovated athletic fields, running track, basketball courts and restrooms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission directs City Staff to re-allocate \$50,000 from the War Memorial Youth Center capital project in the 2024-2028 Five Year Capital Improvement Plan to develop a conceptual design for potential improvements, including outdoor community recreation spaces, to the Coral Gables Senior High School athletic complex.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
