**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-172**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,830.00 FROM PREVIOUSLY ENCUMBERED STATE FORFEITED ASSET FUNDS (F.A.F.) TO ACQUIRE A RUGGEDIZED TABLET STYLE COMPUTER AND ITS ACCOMPANYING SOFTWARE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY AFFAIRS UNIT CRIME PREVENTION AND SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD SECURITY SURVEY PROGRAMS.

**WHEREAS**, The Coral Gables Police Department's investigations of criminal activity produce forfeited funds, both related and unrelated to its participation in the South Florida Money laundering Strike Force operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coral Gables Police Department may lawfully retain at the conclusion of the legal proceedings the forfeited funds as authorized under Florida State Statute 932.7055; and

**WHEREAS**, State Forfeited Asset Funds were previously encumbered under Resolutions 2008-102 and 2009-227 to set aside funds to support crime prevention programs as required by statute; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coral Gables Interim Police Chief, Richard J. Naue, Jr., and the Coral Gables Finance Director, Donald G. Nelson, attest to have deposited the sum of \$3,830.00 in said forfeited funds into the Coral Gables Forfeited Asset Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the FAF Committee met on August 16, 2010, and followed the FAF Committee operating procedures adopted on July 23, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, The FAF Committee approved the Coral Gables Police Chief's request to encumber the available funds on the specific items listed below on this resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby direct the City Manager to authorize the Finance Director to expend \$3,830.00 from previously encumbered State Forfeiture Asset Funds, to acquire a ruggedized tablet style computer and its accompanying software for the Police Department Community Affairs Unit Crime Prevention and Safe Neighborhood security survey programs.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.

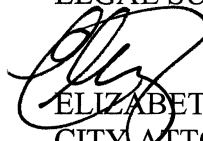
