RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AWARD RFP 2026-009 DANCE PROGRAMMING SERVICES TO FURIA FLAMENA, LLC, THE RECOMMENDED RESPONSIVE-RESPONSIBLE PROPOSER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-763 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED “CONTRACT AWARD”.

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2026, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued, and distributed Request for Proposals (RFP) 2026-009 Dance Programming Services. Eighty three (83) prospective proposers were notified by INFOR, the City’s web-based e-procurement system; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2026, three (3) firms submitted proposals in response to the RFP: Dancefit by Fani, Furia Flamenca LLC., and Verdeja Schools of Ballet, Inc., dba MVSA Studios; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2026, the Evaluation Committee convened to evaluate the one (1) responsive and responsible proposal. The Evaluation Committee recommended that the City negotiate with Furia Flamenca LLC., to provide the requested services; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer recommends accepting the Evaluation Committee’s recommendation to award and negotiate an agreement with Furia Flamenca LLC for RFP 2026-009 Dance Programming Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. That the Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer to award RFP 2026-009 Dance Programming Services to Furia Flamenca LLC, the recommended responsive-responsible proposer, pursuant to Section 2-763 of the Procurement Code entitled “Contract Award”. This authority includes the right to negotiate a final contract for an initial period of three (3) years, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods in an amount not to exceed the available budget or utilize an alternative method until an agreement acceptable to the City is reached.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
