RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF SERVICES TO RELOCATE AND EXPAND THE P25 RADIO SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM COMMUNICATIONS INTERNATIONAL AS A "SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT," PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-689 OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the P25 Radio System, which oversees all City radio equipment, must be relocated and expanded from the existing Public Safety Building to the new Police and Fire Headquarters building; and

- **WHEREAS**, the failure to utilize a L3Harris authorized service provider could result in equipment damage and possible disruption to the City's P25 radio network; and
- **WHEREAS**, Communications International has the necessary specialized training and proprietary certifications required to service and relocate the equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the Police Department has selected Communications International based on its status as an authorized L3Harris partner, provider and seller of this proprietary equipment; and
- **WHEREAS,** the cost for the relocation and expansion of this equipment totals \$317,378; and
- **WHEREAS,** Section 2-689 of the Procurement Code, entitled "Sole Source Procurement" authorizes an award without competitive bids when there is only one source available to fulfill the needs of the City; and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code, entitled "Authority" authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on contract awards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

- **Section 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.
- **Section 2.** That the City Commission accepts the recommendation and authorizes the City Manager to purchase services to relocate and expand the P25 Radio System from Communications International in the amount of \$317,378, pursuant to Section 2-689 of the City's Procurement Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
