When so executed, such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the President and attested to by the Secretary. Any power or authority granted to any representative or attorney-in-fact under the provisions of this article may be revoked at any time by the Board, the Chairman, the President or by the officer or officers granting such power or authority.

**ARTICLE XIII – Execution of Contracts – SECTION 5. Surety Bonds and Undertakings.** Any officer of the Company authorized for that purpose in writing by the chairman or the president, and subject to such limitations as the chairman or the president may prescribe, shall appoint such attorneys-in-fact, as may be necessary to act in behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations. Such attorneys-in-fact subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Company by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Company. When so executed such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the president and attested by the secretary.

**Certificate of Designation** – The President of the Company, acting pursuant to the Bylaws of the Company, authorizes Gregory W. Davenport, Assistant Secretary to appoint such attorneys-in-fact as may be necessary to act on behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations.

**Authorization** – By unanimous consent of the Company's Board of Directors, the Company consents that facsimile or mechanically reproduced signature of any assistant secretary of the Company, wherever appearing upon a certified copy of any power of attorney issued by the Company in connection with surety bonds, shall be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and effect as though manually affixed.

**NOTE 1. BUSINESS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:**

*Business and organization:*

The Company has been engaged in the construction of sewer lift stations, bridges, water control structures, roadways and drainage in Southeast Florida since January 1971.

The work is performed primarily under fixed-price contracts. The length of the Company's contracts varies but it is typically not longer than one year, therefore, assets and liabilities are classified as current and non-current.

*Revenue and cost recognition:*

Revenues from contracts are recognized on the percentage-of-completion method, measured by the percentage that costs to date bear to total estimated costs.

In order to maintain the quality of its work, as is normal for a construction company of this size, the Company may only have a few jobs in progress at any one time. Thus, any job could represent a substantial portion of revenue in a given year. The typical contract length is less than two years.

Contract costs include all direct material and labor and those indirect costs related to contract performance, such as indirect labor, insurance, payroll taxes, supplies, equipment rental, repairs and subcontractor costs. Selling, general and administrative costs are charged to expense as incurred. Provisions for estimated losses on uncompleted contracts are made in the period in which such losses are determined. Changes in job performance, job conditions, and estimated profitability, including contract settlements, may result in revisions to costs and revenue and are recognized in the period in which revisions became known.

The asset, "Costs and estimated earnings in excess of billings on contracts in progress", represents revenues recognized in excess of amounts billed. The liability, "Billings in excess of costs and estimated earnings on contracts in progress", represents billings in excess of revenues recognized.

*Cash and cash equivalents:*

The Company has defined cash equivalents as those highly liquid investments purchased with an original maturity of three months or less.

The Company maintains its cash balances in two financial institutions in Miami, Florida. These balances are insured by the FDIC but they may at times exceed insured limits.

*Property and equipment:*

Property and equipment are stated at cost. Expenditures for major betterments and improvements that extend the lives of the assets are capitalized, while repairs and maintenance that do not improve or extend the lives of the assets are charged to expense currently.

Depreciation is provided principally on the straight-line method based on the estimated useful lives of the assets.

The Company reviews its property and equipment for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the related carrying amount may not be recoverable. When required, impairments losses are recognized based on the excess of the asset's carrying amount and fair value of the asset; long-lived assets to be disposed of are reported at the lower of carrying amounts or fair value less costs to sell. There were no such adjustments during the year ended December 31, 2012.

*Income taxes:*

The Company, with the consent of its shareholders, has elected to be taxed as an S corporation under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and state laws. Under these provisions, the Company does not pay federal and state corporate income taxes on its taxable income. Instead the shareholders are liable for individual income taxes on their respective share of the Company's income or loss. The Company feels it does not have any uncertain tax positions.

*Use of estimates:*

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, the disclosed amounts of contingent assets and liabilities, and the reported amounts of revenues, costs and expenses. Management believes the most significant estimates and assumptions are associated with revenue recognition on construction contracts and valuation of contracts receivable, as well as determination of cost to complete for all contracts in progress. If the underlying estimates and assumptions, upon which the financial statements are based, change in the future, actual amounts may differ from those included in the accompanying financial statements.

*Subsequent Events:*

Management has evaluated all events and transactions that occurred between December 31, 2012 and April 19, 2013, the date these financial statements were available to be issued.

The Company's investments in debt securities are valued at amortized cost which approximates fair value in accordance with FASB 157, Fair Value Measurements issued by the Accounting Standards Codification.

During the year ended December 31, 2011, the Company recognized as an extraordinary items loss on its investment in debt securities of \$416,000 purchased in 2008. The amount of such loss represented management's estimate of the security's original cost over its expected future cash inflows. The present value of such inflows was based on an analysis of failure of the issuer to make recent scheduled interest and principal payments. During 2012 the Company received \$10,428 and through the date of this report an additional \$10,443 in distributions therefore management feels the present value as of December 31, 2012 is reasonable and no further reserves are deemed necessary.

**NOTE 6. LONG-TERM DEBT:**

Equipment obligations maturing at various dates through October 2014, payable in monthly installments totaling \$10,492, including interest, ranging from 6% to 7% and collateralized by equipment costing approximately \$490,000.

**NOTE 7. LINE OF CREDIT:**

The Company has a demand line of credit agreement with a local bank in the amount of \$500,000 to be used for working capital. The interest rate is the prime rate plus .75%. Under the terms of this agreement, the Company must maintain certain financial ratios and equity requirements. The line of credit is secured by a mortgage on the office premises owned by a trust (see Note 8). The balance on the line of credit was \$1,000 at December 31, 2012 and December 31, 2011.

**NOTE 8. RELATED PARTIES:**

A trust in the name of relatives of the majority shareholder of the Company leases the office and warehouse space to the Company on a month to month basis. Rent expense was \$28,463 and \$28,531 for the years ended December 31, 2012 and 2011, respectively.

**NOTE 9. LEASING ARRANGEMENTS:**

Leases are accounted for under the provisions of Statements of Financial Accounting Standards No. 13, "Accounting for Leases" (ASC 840-10), which requires that leases be evaluated and classified as operating or capital leases for financial reporting purposes.

The Company is leasing three vehicles under long-term non-cancelable operating leases. During the year ended December 31, 2012, monthly rentals under these long-term lease obligations were approximately \$3,875. Obligations over the primary terms are expected to mature as follows:



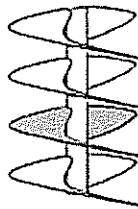
