A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2007-46, TO CHANGE THE SUSPENSION OF FALSE ALARM FINES PROGRAM CHARGES TO SENIOR CITIZENS FROM SEVENTY (70) YEARS OF AGE TO SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE OR OVER; FURTHER STIPULATING THAT SAID AGE REDUCTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON MAY 1, 2008.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:


SECTION 1. That the City Commission does hereby amend Resolution No. 2007-46, thereby changing the age for suspension of false alarm fines from seventy (70) to sixty-five (65) years of age or over.

SECTION 2. That said resolution shall become effective on the date of said amendment, beginning May 1, 2008.
