- 6827 Altamira Street (Subject’s arrest location – had a concealed weapon on his person)
- 6901 Camarin Street (Subject knocked at front door in order to use a phone)
- 6906 Talavera Street (Subject stole a clock)
- 6920 Talavera Street (Possible video surveillance of Subject)
