B. PUBLIC COMMENT

April Jones on behalf of Coral Gables Preparatory Academy PTSA:

- 1) Wants to be proactive in discussing with the city the schedule of the upcoming renovation of Phillips Park. Carolina Vester (City Staff) provided comments: An architecture firm has been engaged. A community meeting will be held, and all will be notified, especially those who are approximately 1500 feet from the property. A survey of the school property nearby is being conducted. Project is approximately two (2) years ago and it's not been fully funded; it's an 8 to 10 K project that includes among other things a pickle ball area. This will be a highlight for the city. There is an MOU in place; this is a public park and to enclose a physical education area will not be done. Further details will be provided as progress is made. The community meeting will most likely occur in late August or September.
- 2) PHIT America program that Vice Mayor Anderson supports: PHIT America had scheduled a walk thru. Wants to know who the authorized parties are to ensure that this moves along.

Samuel Joseph: commentary regarding recent death of a university student outside of Coral Gables Senior High School who was riding a scooter. There are many students who use scooters and e-bikes; this is dangerous and unsafe for those students. The city needs to look at solutions to make it a safer ride for all. Important to get conversations going on looking into possibly additional crossing guards, additional police. Important to come up with a solution to ensure the protection and safety of the kids.

Aillette Diaz from the school district: Provided comments related to Phillips Park. Important to use the park for after-school sport activities. Consider incorporating a school tract team, school pickle ball team. Further commented the importance to schedule a walk-thru of the park.

C. NEW BUSINESS

C-1 Introduction to Fernando Weiner, Government Affairs Manager for Coral Gables (Facilitated by Solanch Lopez, Acting Staff Liaison)

Fernando introduced himself and his role in the city. Board Members introduced themselves.

C-2 Miami-Dade County Public Schools Update (Facilitated by Mari Tere Rojas, School Board Chair)

School Chair was unable to attend the School Community Relations Committee meeting since she is attending the Miami-Dade College 2024 Alumni Hall of Fame induction.

Proffered items from Chief of Staff were not received. Updates provided by Alex Perez from Central Region:

Mr. Perez provided a brief introduction to his role and background.

- He will follow up on the PHIT America site visit request.
- On March 4 School Board Chair Rojas was presented with a highly prestigious award from the Consul General of France. This award was granted for her dedication, enthusiasm in academics and cultural education.
- Gables Prep- Resolution at next School Board meeting to recognize 100 years of the school.
- Henry West Lab magnet letter awards will be sent out today.
- George Carver Elementary will be a 2024 National Magnet School of Excellence, they have the IF Italian program. They are also designated as the STEM Gold designated school for the last four (4) consecutive years.
- George Carver Middle School is going to be a Magnet school of America, it's a school of Excellence and will be running for the 2024 top National Magnet award. The announcement will be held in New York.
- Francis Tucker school will be a full K-8 under the Magnet Stars Program.
- Ponce Middle is a Magnet demonstrations school and a top Magnet School of Excellence. Alec Angulo is a National Finalist for Magnet School of America.
- Sunset Elementary is also a Magnet School of Excellence and a 2023 National Blue Ribbon School and one of Miami Herald's best Elementary schools in Dade County.
- David Fairchild is rated an A school, School of Excellence. Also named NAF distinguished Academy.
- International School Preparatory Academy (ISPA) Magnet School of Excellence 2024.
- · Coral Gables Senior will be receiving a new gym.
- Vice Chairperson Dimitris inquires on required criteria for STEM designation. Mr. Perez responded that STEM designation is a participation by school. Schools must apply and have and have activities throughout the year to be able to be designated as a STEM school. Not every school will apply.

Carlos Pichard is the new contact individual for the May 18, 2024, event. Carolina Vester explained the vendor application form and provided a brief overview of the event.
