A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO TRANSMIT THE CITY'S 2024-2025 ADOPTED BUDGET TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2025, Governor Ron Desantis issued Executive Order 25-44, creating a Department of Government Efficiency ("Florida DOGE") within the Office of Policy and Budget in the Executive Office of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 25-44 charges Florida DOGE with recommending legislative reforms to promote efficiency, maximize productivity, and eliminate waste in state and local government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables has long been committed to fiscal responsibility and the prudent management of public resources; and

WHEREAS, this commitment has resulted in Coral Gables being one of only three municipalities in Florida holding AAA bond ratings from Moody's, Standard & Poor's, and Fitch Ratings; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the City's demonstrated commitment to fiscal responsibility and the prudent management of public resources, the City Commission desires to voluntarily submit the City's 2024-2025 Adopted Budget to Florida DOGE for review and recommendations on potential efficiencies and waste reduction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing **"WHEREAS"** clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is directed to transmit the City's 2024-2025 Adopted Budget, along with a copy of this Resolution, to Florida DOGE for its review and recommendations.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
