RESOLUTION NO. 2025-429

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AWARD RFP 2025-022 DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES TO THE THREE (3) HIGHEST RANKED RESPONSIVE-RESPONSIBLE PROPOSERS IN RANK ORDER: TETRA TECH, INC., (PRIMARY), THOMPSON CONSULTING SERVICES, LLC, (SECONDARY), AND DEBRISTECH, LLC (TERTIARY),, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-763 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED “CONTRACT AWARD”.

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2025, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued, and distributed Disaster Debris Monitoring Services, Request for Proposals (RFP) 2025-022; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2025, six (6) firms responded in response to the RFP, including two (2) No Bid (NB): 1 Asterisk Disasters (NB), DebrisTech, LLC, DIRT Environmental Solutions, Inc. (NB), Tetra Tech, Inc., Tidal Basin Government Consulting, LLC, and Thompson Consulting Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2025, the Evaluation Committee convened to review the three (3) responsive and responsible proposals and ranked the firms in the following order of preference: Tetra Tech, Inc. (first), Thompson Consulting Services, LLC (second), and DebrisTech, LLC (third); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer recommends accepting the Evaluation Committee’s recommendation to award and negotiate an agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc., (Primary), Thompson Consulting Services, LLC, (Secondary), and DebrisTech, LLC (Tertiary), for RFP 2025-022 Disaster Debris Monitoring Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “**WHEREAS**” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.


SECTION 2. That the Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer to award RFP 2025-022 Disaster Debris Monitoring Services to Tetra Tech, Inc., (Primary), Thompson Consulting Services, LLC, (Secondary), and DebrisTech, LLC (Tertiary), the highest ranked responsive-responsible proposers, pursuant to Section 2-763 of the Procurement Code entitled “Contract Award”. This authority includes the right to negotiate a final contract for an initial period of three (3) years, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods, exercisable at the option of the City Manager also in an amount not to exceed the available budget or pursue other alternative methods until an agreement acceptable to the City has been reached.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
