## **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-94**

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION **OF** THE **CHIEF** OFFICER AUTHORIZING PROCUREMENT PIGGYBACK CONTRACT IN **ACCORDANCE** USE WITH **SECTION** 2-978, OF **OTHER** UNIT **GOVERNMENTAL CONTRACTS** ("PIGGYBACK"), WITH DODEC, INC., FROM THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS PROFESSIONAL CONTRACTOR'S CONTRACT, PURSUANT TO UNIT PRICING TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE REPAIR SERVICES FOR TIMELY REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO CITY FACILITIES FOR A PERIOD RUNNING UNTIL JULY 31, 2017, UNDER A JOB ORDER CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the City has a need to hire a General Contractor to provide timely repairs and improvements that can be expedited under a Piggyback Contract that has already been solicited by City of Miami Gardens; and

**WHEREAS**, a new job order contract that would be authorized under this Resolution would allow for various repairs and construction projects as needed until July 31, 2017, as approved under the City's Annual Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends the approval of a contract with DODEC, Inc., under a Piggyback Contract from the City of Miami Gardens to provide for timely repairs and improvements to City facilities as needed;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer authorizing a Piggyback Contract in accordance with Section 2-978. Use Of Other Governmental Unit Contracts ("piggyback"), with DODEC, Inc., from the City of Miami Gardens Professional Contractor's Contract, pursuant to unit pricing to provide construction and maintenance repair services for timely repairs and improvements to City facilities for a period running until July 31, 2017, under a job order contract, subject to final approval and execution of a contract by City staff; and

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
