

**CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2008-28**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES", BY AMENDING SECTION 74-356 ENTITLED "SIX-MONTH NOTICE; INTRODUCTORY PERIOD", TO CHANGE THE COURTESY NOTICE PROVISION FROM SIX-MONTHS TO NINETY-DAYS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER PROVISION; A SAVINGS CLAUSE; A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 74-356 of the "Code of the City of Coral Gables" authorizes a six-month introductory period to receive a courtesy notice of red light signal violations cited with the use of the unmanned cameras/monitoring system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to amend the grace period from six months to ninety- days, in keeping with industry standards;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That Section 74-356 of the "Code of the City of Coral Gables" entitled "Six-Month Notice; Introductory Period", shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 74-356. Ninety-Day Notice; Introductory Period.**

For the first ninety days of this article, unless the driver of a vehicle received a citation from a police officer in accordance with normal traffic enforcement techniques, the vehicle owner shall receive a courtesy notice of the violation; further stating that Commencing ninety-days after the effective date of the article, the vehicle owner is subject to the enforcement provision as provided herein.

**SECTION 3.** That if any section, part of section, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall not be affected.


**SECTION 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** That this Ordinance shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


