**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-243**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF ALCOHOL AND THE WAIVING OF THE COST OF PARKING METER RENTALS AFTER 5:00 PM ON THE 100 BLOCK OF GIRALDA AVENUE ON THE FIRST FRIDAY OF EACH MONTH FROM NOVEMBER 2010 THROUGH MARCH 2011, A TOTAL OF FIVE EVENTS, FOR THE “*GIRALDA UNDER THE STARS STREET FESTIVAL*.”**

**WHEREAS**, last year the Coral Gables Business Improvement District implemented a pilot program for the 100 block of Giralda Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the program was very well received by the public and business community at large; and

**WHEREAS**, this effort helps revitalize the restaurants on Giralda Avenue and increases foot traffic throughout the Central Business District; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to support this effort; and

**WHEREAS**, the Section 74-140(f) of the Code of the City of Coral Gables allows for the City Commission to waive the cost metered parking;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby grant the waiver of the cost of parking meter rentals after 5 p.m., on the 100 block of Giralda Avenue on the first Friday of each month from November 2010 through March 2011, a total of five events, for the “*Giralda Under the Stars Street Festival*”; and

**SECTION 3.** That the sale of alcohol during these events is hereby approved; and

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
