**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 74, "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES," TO CREATE "ARTICLE X- PERSONAL DELIVERY DEVICES AND MOBILE CARRIERS" TO IMPOSE CERTAIN SAFETY AND OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONAL DELIVERY DEVICES AND MOBILE CARRIERS CONSISTENT WITH STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

The presence of personal delivery devices (PDDs) and mobile carriers has become more widespread in Coral Gables and the surrounding areas in the last few years. The City of Coral Gables wishes to impose additional regulations on the safe operation of these personal delivery devices consistent with Section 316.2071, Florida Statutes. This Ordinance adopts regulations regarding the speed of the devices, visibility measures, insurance requirements, and proof of active monitoring. There have been no changes since first reading.
