


PROCESS

- The City received a partial-gift proposal from the Julio Larraz Foundation through Jose Valdes-Fauli for the City to fabricate a sculptural work by the artist in celebration of a retrospective exhibition of the artist's career at the Coral Gables Museum
- May 26, 2021, The Arts Advisory Panel reviewed the initial proposal and suggested a follow-up proposal responding to their comments
- December 1, 2021 April 30, 2022 Coral Gables Museum Exhibition:
 "The Kingdom We Carry Inside"
- March 9, 2022, The Arts Advisory Panel reviewed a revised proposal and recommended approval to the Cultural Development Board
- March 15, 2022, The Cultural Development Board reviewed the proposal and is recommending approval to the City Commission.

- Accomplished painter, sculptor, draftsman
- Best known by his precise and detailed technique, imagination, and subtle touch

- Exhibits throughout the world, including frequently in Italy and New York
- Artworks are in prominent public collections including Mexico,
 Colombia, France, Philadelphia, New York and Florida


