Resolution of the City of Coral Gables authorizing the Settlement of the Lawsuit  
Styled City of Coral Gables v. Quantum Leap Network, Inc., Robert Burr and  
Robin Burr, pending in the Circuit Court for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit in and  
for Miami-Dade County, Florida, Case No. 09-17991-CA-27.

Mayor Cason: Alright, we have no City Manager items today and we have three items by the City Attorney.

City Attorney Leen: Thank you Mr. Mayor. First, I would like to discuss Item I-1. Mr. Rogero could you please come up. This is a Resolution of the City of Coral Gables authorizing the settlement of the lawsuit between Coral Gables and Quantum Leap Network, Robert Burr and Robin Burr, it came before the agenda previously, it came before the Commission previously and we took the Commission’s suggestions and we went back and Mr. Rogero is going to describe what those agreements are, they are not attached to this Resolution, although originally the intent was to do that because we just got the final signatures on them. So I am going to have Mr.

Rogero describe them for you. We believe that it will completely resolve this matter as to both of the websites at issue. Mr. Rogero could you please describe the agreements?

Mr. Rogero: Good morning Mr. Mayor, Commissioners, you will recall that this matter involved securing the rights to the domain name venetianpool.com. There was a contract from several years back that allowed Quantum Leap to maintain the website at that domain address for a number of years, but they were also suppose to transfer the ownership of the domain name to the City; and a couple of years ago, as part of the City's effort to try to control the domain names of various sites and facilities operated by this City, we asked for compliance of that agreement did not get it, we had to file litigation and pursuant to direction received from the Commission, we have now negotiated and completed a settlement agreement whereby this domain name will be transferred to the City. In addition a second domain name which was coralgablesvenetianpool.com that had been registered by another individual. We also have an agreement from that individual to transfer that domain name to the City. As a result of the settlement agreement the litigation will be dismissed with prejudice. Each party will bear its own costs and fees and we will go forward with the City's ownership of these two domain names and its ability to post information about that facility as it sees fit.
