**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-320**

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S APPLICATION TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2009 DRUG CONTROL AND SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT FORMULA GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,142, TO FUND THE TEEN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROJECT.

**WHEREAS,** The Coral Gables Police Department is the established local law enforcement agency for the provision of law enforcement services within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Coral Gables; and

**WHEREAS,** The U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs, through the Miami-Dade County Office of Grants Coordination has grant funding programs for local law enforcement agencies; and

**WHEREAS,** The Coral Gables Police Department has identified the need to educate and give counseling and assistance within the City through the development of a teen domestic violence program conducted by the Victim's Advocate; and

**WHEREAS,** this Resolution will satisfy the Miami-Dade County's requirement that the local governing body has been noticed that a local law enforcement agency has applied for grant funding for a program in their jurisdiction;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby authorize the City Manager to support Coral Gables Police Department in their application to the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs, Miami-Dade County Office of Grants, to fund the Teen Domestic Violence Project..

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
