# Call to Order:

Meeting was called to order by Sue Kawalerski at 5:47 PM. Sue Kawalerski, Roberta Neway, Debbie Swain, David Fournier, Oscar Sosa, and Silvia Pinera-Vazquez were in attendance. Peter Wood was absent. Debbie motioned to make Peters absences excused, the motion was seconded by Roberta, all were in favor. Quorum was met.

# Meeting Minutes Approval:

The Board minutes for the TAB meeting that took place on May 17, 2022 were presented for the Board's approval. Sue requested some changes to the minutes. Sue requested for "public comments/guest comments" be inserted after "Board discussion". Sue also requested for her statement regarding the South Alhambra Bike Lane presentation to say, "Accidents involving a pedestrian and a bicycle can be more dangerous than a car and a bicycle". The statement is not true to the recording. The Board asked who is responsible for creating the agenda. Also, the Board questioned how items can be added to the agenda,

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including items that require follow up. The Board agreed to take responsibility for each member items and be proactive when the draft agenda is circulated. Minutes were approved as amended.

## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

- Sidewalks and Scooters Sue summarized the email from resident Vicki Cerda regarding an accident with a scooter. The Board asked Sgt. Lopez what is being done to remedy scooters on prohibited sidewalks. Sgt. Lopez responded they are working on an educational campaign, and improved signage. The Board discussed this topic being an item at the previous Commission meeting.
- **Codina Project** Melissa showed the Board the developer's plans. Sue asked if a travel lane is being taken away. Melissa clarified that a travel lane was not being taken away and that bulb outs are being incorporated. Data was collected for a traffic impact study for the proposed project. Sue requested the scope of work from the engineers and how many traffic studies have been the cause of approval or disapproval of a developer's plan in the last 5 years. Sue stated that the end goal is to revise how traffic engineers are doing their business.
- **Purpose of the TAB** Sue presented with the revisions to be made to the "Purpose of the Board" Resolution. The Board agreed with the revisions and was motioned by Debbie, seconded by Oscar, all in favor.

#### Traffic Project Updates

- Biltmore Way Streetscape (Dover Kohl)
  - Melissa advised the Board of an upcoming internal site meeting to review the project. Sue requested for a TAB member to be present. Melissa advised the Board that this is not a Sunshine Meeting and having more than one Board member would require this to be a Sunshine Meeting.

Staff advised the Board that the City is working on the design. The City is looking into a potential protected bike lane and the first floor would be of flexible use.
