ITEM TITLE:

Ordinance on Second Reading. An Ordinance providing for the levy of taxes for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023; fixing the rate of such levy; providing for the segregation and the application of the proceeds of such levy; providing for the separability of the provisions hereof; and providing that this ordinance shall become effective October 1, 2022. (Passed 1st reading on September 13, 2022)

BRIEF HISTORY:

At a budget workshop on July 25, 2022, the City Commission adopted a tentative millage rate for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 of 5.559; unchanged from the 5.559 rate adopted for Fiscal Year 2021-2022. The tentative millage rate of 5.559 was used by the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser to prepare the 2022 Notice of Proposed Property Taxes that was sent to the Coral Gables property owners as a notification of their potential property taxes, as well as the date, time and meeting information for the 1st public hearing to discuss the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Annual Budget. The date, time and place of the 2nd public hearing was included in the "Notice of Proposed Tax Increase" advertised on Saturday, September 24, 2022 in the main section of the Miami Herald, as well as in the display case in the main entrance of City Hall.
