## CORAL GABLES SIGNAGE

The City of Coral Gables runs 2 trolley routes serving an average of 3,800 daily weekly riders and 1,500 on Saturdays.

- The trolley system includes 65 trolley stops
- Sign replacement project is partially funded with \$35,000 matching FDOT grant
- Expected to be completed by January 2023

The City of Coral Gables maintains 21 surface parking lots.

- 6 parking lot signs have been refurbished or had signs replaced in the last 2-3 years
- An additional 3 parking lots are scheduled to be done in 2023
- The remaining signs will be replaced as part of a Citywide Wayfinding and Signage Program
- Wayfinding Program is scheduled to be started in 2023





## CORAL GABLES SIGNAGE

The City of Coral Gables has just under 13,000 street signs, including approximately 1,000 that are under the City's jurisdiction, plus 2,426 street monuments.

- City staff addresses stickers, graffiti, and the straightening of non-City signs as necessary
- Replacement for 100 faded speed limit signs have been received
- A sample of the signs will be tested for compliance with specifications
- Installation to be completed by January 2023
