1. Motion to approve Oct. 12, 2022, Minutes

2. Holiday Outreach

Pantin shared the events happening in Coral Gables for the holiday season and showcased the "South Gables Living" article about happening events.

3. Coral Gables Map

Crowther requested that in addition to the current list there be a man on the street view as well and that ideally it would be with Story Corp. Staff advised that it was planning to do a man on the street at the Farmers Market.

Crowther thought it was important to involve school children on the day of the centennial in some manner.

Arellano thought it would be great if the city could get Dave Barry who is a resident to participate in the project.

Pantin advised that she is planning to reach out to other committees and boards for input. Crowther offered to assist in this endeavor.

6. Why Coral Gables? Update

Pantin provided an update on the campaign. The campaign has performed very well with engagement and increased the number of LinkedIn followers. Pantin thanked Arellano for the Cosentino contact. The Cosentino video will be part of the second series of videos and will premiere in January.

Villamil suggested that a series with local consulates be considered. Pantin advised that there had been a previous effort titled We are coral Gables that featured consulates that had not performed well.
