1. Proposed art works for the 2015 ARTcycle in Public Places (Action)

Ms. Birdsill informed the Board that the Coral Gables Museum had chosen the artists who would participate in the third annual ARTcycle from March 5 through May 24, 2015. The exhibit includes installing art works, which are constructed using recycled bicycle parts, in prominent public places, including the Coral Gables Museum, the War Memorial Youth Center, Merrick Park across from City Hall, the Village at Merrick Park, Ponce Circle Park and the Biltmore Hotel. She handed out pictures of the selected art works, adding that they were "witty and fun." The proposed works were well received by the Board, which said it would help to promote awareness of bicycle safety.
