On 01/23/15, Officer Dickinson observed a Black Bronco pull into the gas station (Marathon) at 375 South Dixie Hwy which matched a BOLO that was issued by Detective Moises on 01/20/15. The Black Bronco was possibly related to a vehicle burglary incident that occurred on 01/07/14. Officer Dickinson noticed a black male exit the vehicle and who was later identified as Alonzo Bohannon. After a preliminary investigation, it was revealed that the subject attempted to make a fraudulent purchase with a stolen credit card (case #15-000541). The stolen card was recovered inside the trash receptacle near where the subject's vehicle was parked. A search of the subject and his vehicle revealed in his possession- \$1500 (us currency), a Michael Kors watch, and a pair of Maui Jim sunglasses. After an interview from CID it was determined that the credit card was stolen from a vehicle burglary near Bird Road and SW 69th Avenue. Officer Dickinson arrested the subject and charged him accordingly.

Due to the quick actions of Ofc. Dickinson a vehicle burglary subject was apprehended before he could use the victims' credit card. That is why I am nominating him for Officer of the Month for January 2015.
