A RESOLUTION NAMING THE PASSIVE PARK AT THE CORNER OF ALHAMBRA CIRCLE AND MENDAVIA AVENUE IN HONOR OF BETSY ADAMS AND THE CORAL GABLES GARDEN CLUB.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

WHEREAS, Betsy Adams' leadership of the Garden Club and her community service over the last fifty-six years have produced enormous enhancements to the historical, cultural, educational, recreational, and aesthetic reputation of the City; and

WHEREAS, Betsy Adams and the Garden Club worked together on projects such as "The Coral Gables Adopt-An-Entrance Project", the George Merrick statue at City Hall, and the statue of Althea Merrick at the historic Merrick House on Coral Way; and

WHEREAS, The City of Coral Gables, its residents, businesses and visitors are beneficiaries of Betsy Adams' vision and leadership; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it should rename the park as stated herein and without invocation of the application process in Resolution No. 30314-A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the Alhambra Circle Park to be named in honor of Betsy Adams and the Coral Gables Garden Club.

SECTION 3. That said resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
