# NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

**WHEREAS,** Betsy Adams' leadership of the Garden Club and her community service over the last fifty-six years have produced enormous enhancements to the historical, cultural, educational, recreational, and aesthetic reputation of the City; and

**WHEREAS,** Betsy Adams and the Garden Club worked together on projects such as "The Coral Gables Adopt-An-Entrance Project", the George Merrick statue at City Hall, and the statue of Althea Merrick at the historic Merrick House on Coral Way; and

WHEREAS, The City of Coral Gables, its residents, businesses and visitors are beneficiaries of Betsy Adams' vision and leadership; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission has determined that it should rename the park as stated herein and without invocation of the application process in Resolution No. 30314-A.

# NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 3.** That said resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
