WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it should rename the park as stated herein and without invocation of the application process in Resolution No. 30314-A;

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.
