Approval.


BRIEF HISTORY:

The F.A.F. consists of the proceeds from the seizure and forfeiture of certain assets identified during criminal investigation to have been possessed or utilized in violation of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act.




Under FSS 932.7055, the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, a local law enforcement agency that acquires at least \$15,000 in such proceeds in a fiscal year must expend or donate no less than 15% of forfeited asset proceeds for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and drug abuse education and prevention programs.

The F.A.F. Committee met on October 29, 2015 and approved this encumbrance.
