## CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY STAFF TO UNDERTAKE A STUDY OF THE POSSIBLE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES OF THE AREAS KNOWN AS "LITTLE GABLES," 'PONCE-DAVIS," AND "HIGH PINES," AND PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE CITY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, interest has been expressed in the annexation to the City of Coral Gables of the areas known as "Little Gables," "Ponce-Davis," and "High Pines"; and

WHEREAS, a study should be conducted to determine whether the annexation of these areas is in the best interest of the City and the public; and

WHEREAS, as part of the study a fiscal impact to the City's annexation of these areas should be included; and

**WHEREAS**, an analysis of the impacts to City departments such as Police, Parks, Fire, Public Works, Planning and Zoning, and Building of these annexations is also needed; and

**WHEREAS,** this study should occur prior to initiating the procedure with Miami-Dade County to seek annexation of these areas.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution upon the adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager and City Staff shall submit the results of the study in accordance with this resolution so that the Commission can make a determination whether it is appropriate to initiate the annexation request.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
