
Biographical Summary for Colonel Dennis L. Daley (Retired)



Colonel (Ret) Dennis L. Daley is a decorated Air Force veteran with career highlights that include twenty-four years flying the F-4 and F-16 fighter aircraft, combat missions in Iraq, and six years as the 482nd Fighter Wing Mission Support Group Commander at Homestead Air Reserve Base. In that role he exercised command over the base installation and facilities, airfield, 1,000 personnel in nineteen organizations, and managed a budget exceeding \$37 million annually.

Colonel Daley's flying career spans both military and civilian flying. He is presently employed by Delta Air Lines as a B-777 pilot, where he routinely pilots international flights to destinations such as South Africa, Korea, Singapore, Hong Kong, Dubai, Japan, and China.

In addition to his Delta Airlines responsibilities, Colonel Daley has served as a small business and business development consultant to Reef Radio Electronics at Ocean Reef and to Solarbeam International in Homestead. Colonel Daley is also the President and CEO of Vision Foreign Trade Zone #166, a 1,000 acre Foreign Trade Zone overlying the Homestead Park of Commerce.

Colonel Daley is a long-time resident of Coral Gables, and is active in many organizations such as the Air Force Association, Reserve Officers Association, the National Association of Foreign Trade Zones, the Homestead Chamber of Commerce, and the Homestead Military Affairs Committee.
