#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY STAFF TO UNDERTAKE A STUDY OF THE POSSIBLE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES OF THE AREAS KNOW AS "LITTLE GABLES," 'PONCE-DAVIS," AND "HIGH PINES," AND PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE CITY COMMISSION.


WHEREAS, interest has been expressed in the annexation to the City of Coral Gables of the areas known as "Little Gables," "Ponce-Davis," and "High Pines"; and

WHEREAS, a study should be conducted to determine whether the annexation of these areas is in the best interest of the City and the public; and

WHEREAS, as part of the study a fiscal impact to the City's annexation of these areas should be included; and

WHEREAS, an analysis of the impacts to City departments such as Police, Parks, Fire, Public Works, Planning and Zoning, and Building of these annexations is also needed; and

WHEREAS, this study should occur prior to initiating the procedure with Miami-Dade County to seek annexation of these areas;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager and City Staff shall submit the results of the study in accordance with this resolution so that the Commission can make a determination whether it is appropriate to initiate the annexation request.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
