I. CALL TO ORDER

- Parents have anecdotally reported a reduction in the amount of homework assigned to their children, especially at Sunset Elementary
- Building a good relationship with MDCPS staff, board members thanked Iraida for her hard work and commitment

B. MDCPS Staff Report

- Coral Gables Prep and Sunset Elementary are currently at full capacity
- Controlled Choice is over
- Sunset will see a boundary change and function like West Lab in 2017-2018 school year
- Committee members and staff asked for further clarification regarding any changes to Sunset Elementary's boundaries (a response from MDCPS is forthcoming)

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. Coral Gables Dental Clinic

- Dr. Torres (Dental Director) presented information about the free dental clinic to the board members
- The dental clinic was founded by the Woman's Club in 1939 and since then has been operated and funded in large part by the Club
- Parents who work can apply for free dental care for their children, program is offered to residents of Miami-Dade county
- Dr. Torres said they need more patients and Iraida said she would help get the word out in the coming school year
- Dr. Torres hosted a tour of the clinic following the meeting
