RESOLUTION NO. 2016-196
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO PROCEED WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PLAN TO IMPLEMENT A 25 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON ALL RESIDENTIAL STREETS. (DEFERRED ITEM FROM JULY 26, 2016 CITY COMMISSION MEETING).

WHEREAS, the City Commission has discussed lowering the speed limit to 25 mph , in response to residential concerns throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, The City of Coral Gables submitted the analysis to Miami Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works (MDCDTPW), recommending a posted speed limit of 25 mph on all residential streets; and

WHEREAS, Miami Dade County approved the City's request to lower the posted speed limit to 25 mph only on residential local roads maintained by the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, Public Works has received support from Hammock Oaks Association and Kings Bay in favor of the speed limit reduction; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Board recommended lowering the speed limit on July 19, 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby approve the Public Works Department to proceed with the development of a plan to implement a 25 mph speed limit on all residential streets.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
