## **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-196**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO PROCEED WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PLAN TO IMPLEMENT A 25 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON ALL RESIDENTIAL STREETS. (DEFERRED ITEM FROM JULY 26, 2016 CITY COMMISSION MEETING).

WHEREAS, the City Commission has discussed lowering the speed limit to 25mph, in response to residential concerns throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, The City of Coral Gables submitted the analysis to Miami Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works (MDCDTPW), recommending a posted speed limit of 25 mph on all residential streets; and

WHEREAS, Miami Dade County approved the City's request to lower the posted speed limit to 25 mph only on residential local roads maintained by the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, Public Works has received support from Hammock Oaks Association and Kings Bay in favor of the speed limit reduction; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Board recommended lowering the speed limit on July 19, 2016;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby approve the Public Works Department to proceed with the development of a plan to implement a 25 mph speed limit on all residential streets.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
