RESOLUTION NO. 2016-188

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AUTHORIZE AN ENTERPRISE LICENSE AGREEMENT (ELA) TO OBTAIN GIS ENTERPRISE LICENSES AT AN ANNUAL COST OF \$35,000 FROM ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEM RESEARCH INSTITUTE, INC., (ESRI), THE CURRENT VENDOR OF GIS APPLICATIONS, SERVICES, AND SUPPORT FOR CORAL GABLES, AS A "SOLE SOURCE" PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-770 OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables, through the IT Department's GIS Section, has been using for over twenty (20) years the industry standard, ESRI GIS software architecture for displaying and analyzing geographic information; and

WHEREAS, the maps and derivative charts and displays produced by the GIS Section have served the City's decision-making processes and presentation needs over those years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables desires to advance the capability of GIS services through enhanced features for enterprise applications, sustainability management, public notice, smart devices, mobile services, data analytics, and cloud computing; and

WHEREAS, an enterprise agreement with ESRI offers significant cost avoidance over piecemeal license acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer pursuant to Section 2-770 of the Procurement Code has determined that ESRI is the sole source provider of GIS products and services needed for the City's existing GIS software architecture under the Enterprise License Agreement (ELA); and

WHEREAS, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code, entitled "Authority" authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The forgoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption herein.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby accept the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer to authorize an Enterprise License Agreement (ELA) to obtain GIS Enterprise Licenses at an annual cost of \$35,000 from Environmental System Research Institute, Inc., (ESRI), the current vendor of GIS applications, services, and support for Coral Gables, as a "Sole Source" pursuant to Section 2-770 of the City's Procurement Code; subject to final approval and execution of a contract by City staff.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
