Mr. Pastor called the Cultural Development Board meeting to order at 8:16 a.m.

ARTS ADVISORY PANEL VACANCY (DISCUSSION & ACTION):

Ms. Cathers reviewed the role of the Cultural Development Board in recommending Arts Advisory Panel members to the City Commission. The Board reviewed recommendations received by the City and through Board members, Arts Advisory Panel members, and staff. The Board noted the high quality of

recommendations and discussed the advantage of greater professional diversity within the Panel and the advantage of having a member with professional conservation experience who can address material concerns (such as maintenance, environmental issues, longevity, etc.).

The Board's discussion focused on Ms. Lowinger and Ms. Hall, with the Board acknowledging Ms. Lowinger's extensive experience and reputation in the area of conservation. Ms. Cathers advised the Board of Ms. Lowinger's current contracts with the City and potential of future restoration contracts. Ms. Hall was acknowledged for her professional background, previous experience working with Ms. Lowinger, and the preferable choice as she is the staff conservator at Vizcaya Museum and Gardens and currently has no potential conflicts of interest with the City.

Ms. Burgos made a motion to recommend appointment of Lauren Hall to the Arts Advisory Panel. Mr. Perez seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:29.
