THIS MEMORANDUM	OF UNDERSTA	NDING (the "Ag	greement") by and between
the City of Coral Gables, Florida,	a municipal corp	oration organized	under the laws of the State
of Florida (the "City") and Tahiti	Beach Homeowr	ners Association, l	Inc., a Florida not for profi
("Tahiti Beach HOA"), is entered	into this	_ day of	, 2017.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Tahiti Beach HOA owns the real property consisting of Tracts J, K, L, and M, of Cocoplum Section Two, Plat E (the common area of Tahiti Beach Homeowners Association under folio number 03-4132-030-0410, and

WHEREAS, Tahiti Beach HOA is requesting that the City's Police Department and Code Enforcement Department patrol the Tahiti Beach area as it does any other neighborhood in Coral Gables, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2684 passed by the City Commission in 1987, approving Cocoplum Section Two, Plat E (the subdivision n/k/a Tahiti Beach) requires access on the private street to any authorized City representative, and

WHEREAS, the City and the Tahiti Beach HOA have determined that such patrolling is is in the best interests of the City and Tahiti Beach HOA,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, Tahiti Beach HOA and the City enter into this Memorandum of Understanding and agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- 2. Ordinance No. 2684 approving Cocoplum Section Two, Plat E, specifically states under Section 16.6. that access to Tract "M" (the private street) shall be available at all times to any authorized representative of the City of Coral Gables.
- 3. Tahiti Beach HOA is specifically requests City Police Officers to patrol Tahiti Beach as they do any other neighborhood in Coral Gables. Tahiti Beach HOA acknowledges that access is required under Ordinance no. 2684.

- 4. Tahiti Beach HOA additionally requests that Code Enforcement Officers patrol Tahiti Beach as they would any other similarly situated neighborhoods.
- 5. The term of this Agreement is for so long as Plat E is in existence and the City Commission does not pass an Ordinance rescinding or restricting the access required for any Coral Gables authorized representative under Ordinance No. 2684.
- 6. All notices required pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered by hand or by United States Postal Service, certified mail service, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the following addressees of record:
