The following represents a summary of the items discussed during the Committee meeting.

#### -MEETING AGENDA -

## I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 8:33am.

## II. ROLL CALL

All board members were present except for Theresa Rice who had a family emergency. A quorum was present.

## III. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Nan made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 20<sup>th</sup> SCRC meeting, Kris seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

## IV. OLD BUSINESS

- **a.** West Lab Elementary School
  - The board discussed the history of the West Lab negotiations and the proposed expansion scheduled for the Development Review Committee
  - The board also discussed the draft Resolution, what it means in the larger context, timing and implications
  - Commissioner Keon feels we do not have adequate seats (or space)in public elementary schools for Coral Gables residents
  - Iraida says the community needs to show up and demand a seat at their local school i.e. a grassroots effort
  - Commissioner Keon wants SCRC to go back to ABC to ask for change in Craft Section boundary in order to move students from Tucker Elementary to Carver Elementary
  - Iraida mentions the transfer process, stating "If a school has capacity, schools are compelled to let in any kid, from anywhere"
  - The board votes on the West Lab resolution:

A RESOLUTION BY THE CORAL GABLES SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS COMMITTEE URGING THE CITY COMMISSION TO PURCHASE A DEDICATED CLASSROOM AT HENRY S. WEST LABORATORY SCHOOL AT A COST OF APPROXIMATELY \$4.5 MILLION DOLLARS, SECURING ONE CLASSROOM PER GRADE LEVEL FROM KINDERGARDEN THROUGH EIGTH GRADE, FOR A TOTAL OF APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY STUDENT STATIONS, FOR CORAL GABLES RESIDENTS IN PERPETUITY.

Mary moves the Resolution, Sam seconds the motion, Mary, Aileen, Sam, and Kris vote in favor, Nan abstains. The motion passes.

## b. Special Needs Initiative

- Sam has typed up the meeting notes from the last Special Needs Planning meeting, asks board to vote on whether to submit notes to Commission for consideration and guidance.
- Nan makes a motion to submit the SNI meeting notes to Commission for consideration and guidance, Sam seconds the motion. The motion passes unanimously.

# V. NEW BUSINESS

# a. Representative Rojas' School Board Items

- Sam provides a summary of sponsored items
- Both items passed unanimously at School Board
  - School Board authorized superintendent to conduct a feasibility study for body cameras in public schools and consider a pilot program for the 2017-2018 school year.
  - School Board authorized superintendent to provide a status report with recommendations to formalize a Districtwide Safety and Security Committee by April 5, 2017.
