

## EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH NOMINATION FORM

If selected, the Employee of the Month receives \$400 cash along with a plaque presented during a City Commission meeting. A photo of the employee is also displayed in City Hall for the duration of that month, as well throughout City departments. In addition, the Rotary Club of Coral Gables honors the chosen employee with a plaque presented during their monthly luncheon. Additionally, Employees of the Month become eligible for Employee of the Year.

Eligibility - All regular, full time employees except for: temporary, seasonal or employees on probation, employee's eligible for Police Officer or Firefighter of the Month programs, Directors, Assistant Directors, and those who have been previous Employees of the Year.

Procedures - Nominations may be submitted by any Coral Gables Director, or resident.
