

ITEM TITLE:

Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Coral Gables Reaffirming its Opposition to the Federal Legislation Allowing For The Potential Increase in Truck Weights or Lengths Operating on Federal, State, County and Local Roadways Within the State of Florida

BRIEF HISTORY:

On October 25, 2011 the City Commission of the City of Coral Gables passed resolution number 2011-262
opposing attempts being made at the federal level to increase the size, weight and allowable number of trailers on
existing road infrastructure. Currently, the federal legislature is again being lobbied to raise the weights of trucks
and length, and the City wants to reaffirm its opposition to any similar legislation.
